**Partial Sheriff's Office Closure – Wednesday, January 30<sup>th</sup>**

The Lake County Sheriff's Office Business Offices and lobbies, along with numerous other Lake County government offices, will be closed on Wednesday, January 30, 2019, due to the dangerously cold weather expected in Lake County. Wind chills tomorrow are expected to be between -45° to -55°.

Lake County Sheriff's 911 Emergency Communications Section, Highway Patrol Division, Corrections Division, and Criminal Investigations Division will be fully-operational tomorrow.

Sheriff John Idleburg said, "Tomorrow we are urging everyone who doesn't have to venture out on the roadways to stay home, and this applies for our non-correctional and non-enforcement employees. If you need police services tomorrow, call 911 in an emergency and 847-549-5200 for non-emergencies. Our telecommunicators and first-responders will be there to answer the call and respond 24/7."
